We were quick to recognise the potential of low-emission, noise-reduced vehicles, and have developed ways of ensuring that our subcontractors abide by these rules and regulations.

We have also imposed internal restrictions on dangerous goods transport (selected commodities only), thus reducing the risk of environmental damage to road and rail.

Our decision to adhere to our environmental philosophy in the procurement of all products and services and in new and replacement investments has encouraged the use of new technologies and has, in turn, resulted in the optimum use of resources (energy, water, raw materials etc.).
